According to Euphrates Post, "Coalition aircraft caused the deaths of four other [civilians] last night, a result of four air raids targeting the village of Hattash which is under the control of Islamic state in eastern Raqqa, which also caused considerable destruction to a number of residential buildings in the center of the village. It is noteworthy that the international airline alliance has intensified its air raids on positions controlled by the organization [IS] in the northern, eastern and western countryside to coincide with the advance of SDF in the west of the city." Smart and Syrian Mirror said the Coalition was responsible and that three of the four civilians killed were from one family – and included a woman. Eldorar also blamed the Coalition and put the death toll at five.
