> December 12th 2015: Kabsh, Al Raqqah governorate, Syria Summary: At least six civilians were killed and four injured in what was reported as a Coalition drone strike at Kabsh in northern Al

Raggah.

The attack targeted what was described as "a small convoy of vehicles transporting passengers." A minibus carrying the civilians

was said to have been destroyed.

DESCRIPTION: The Syrian Press centre was the only source not to attribute blame to

the Coalition, citing "an unknown party."

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Coalition position: The Coalition did not publicly report any strikes in Al Raggah for December 11th-12th 2015.

For December 12th-13th 2015 it did confirm attacking vehicles: "Near Ar Raqqah, two strikes struck two separate ISIL tactical units and destroyed two ISIL vehicles and wounded two ISIL fighters."

There was 1 strike (RTF Strike # (b)(1)1.4a in the vicinity of Kabsh on 12 December 2015. The strike targeted ISIL

fighters in a dynamic vehicle located approximately 16

miles north-west of Raqqah. The strike was taken in

favorable conditions when no civilians were in the vicinity.

Post-strike imagery from ISR FMV showed no collateral damage from the strike. Based on review of imagery from

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ISR FMV and the strike description mismatch with that of the alleged CIVCAS, Task Force 94-7 has determined that this reported CIVCAS allegation is not credible.
