Summary: Locals reported that eight civilians died after Coalition or Iraq government aircraft struck the Jerri and Amina neighborhoods of Hit. Among those killed was a family of six: a Facebook tribute page noted: "This is a picture of the martyr Riad Ahmed Rzeyk, who was forced out of his house in the Railway Qaurter by Daash, and so moved to the Aminah neighborhood. There his house was bombed

DESCRIPTION: by mistake which led to his martyrdom and that of his four children

and his wife." While most blamed the US-led Coalition, Iraqi Spring instead blamed "the air force" - possibly a reference to the Iraqi military. Among those reported killed were: Mohammad Ghassan Khashan - a barber Ahmed Shaban abd Al Rahman Al Hiti Riad Ahmed Rzeyk, his wife Raghad and their four children Civilians

reported killed: 8, including 4 children and 1 woman
