Pro-Syrian opposition social media users condemned the attack. This topic trended and resonated at a low level in the Arabic IE. 2. Is this in Airwars? YES If yes, Title: June 20th 2017: Khisham, Eastern Deir Ezzor, Deir Ezzor governorate, Syria Synopsis: Up to 16 civilians, including several women and children, were killed and dozens more injured in airstrikes on Khisham village in Deir Ezzor governorate. However it was not clear who was responsible with allegations lodged against the Coalition, the Russian air force and the Syrian government. In total, five sources alleged that the Coalition was responsible, four sources said Bashar al Assad's government was to blame, three said Russia was responsible and six sources did not reach a final conclusion apportioning blame. A number of reliable sources – including Smart News Agency, Euphrates Post, Radio al Kul and Baladi News – reported that phosphorous munitions were used in the attack, likely to be a contributing factor to the high casualty rates. Several sources also reported that after the initial strike, the aircrafts returned and targeted a house where civilians had taken cover during the original attack.
