April 22nd 2016: Mosul, Nineveh province, Iraq

Summary: Four families comprising 36 civilians, including women and children, were killed in the Al-Maliya district east of Mosul in a strike by the international coalition, according to a senior medical

source in Nineveh quoted by NINA.

In a rare named citation, Director of the Emergency General Hospital

in Mosul Dr. Mahdi al-Rubaie told the National Iraqi News Agency that "the international coalition bombed a Daesh site resulting in the

martyrdom of four families east of Mosul."

NINA noted that Dr al-Rubaie added that the bodies of "36 civilians, including 17 women and 11 children arrived at the forensic medicine

in Mosul at dawn today."

In what may be a linked event, MNN reported the death of an internally displaced woman from Salahudin province, killed after a

Coalition strike in the agriculture neighbourhood.

Coalition position: The Coalition reports for April 21st-22nd 2016 that "Near Mosul, five strikes struck three separate ISIL tactical units and destroyed an ISIL weapons cache, an ISIL assembly area, and three ISIL supply caches and suppressed two separate ISIL fighting positions."

For April 22nd-23rd it noted: "Near Mosul, three strikes struck two separate ISIL tactical units and destroyed two ISIL weapons caches, an ISIL check point, two ISIL vehicles, and an ISIL VBIED."

There was 1 strike (RTF Strike # (b)(1)1.4a in the vicinity of Mosul on 22 April 2016. The strike targeted Objective (b)(6) traveling in a dynamic vehicle in Mosul. The strike was taken in favorable conditions when no civilians were in the vicinity. Post-strike imagery from ISR FMV showed no collateral damage from the strike. However, because the post-strike imagery is zoomed in so close to the target, the Geospatial Exploitation Team (b)(1)1.4a was consulted to review the ISR FMV to further assess the BDA. It was determined that this strike did not result in any collateral damage or CIVCAS. Task Force 94-7 has determined that this reported CIVCAS allegation is not credible. ASSESSMENT CIVCAS: No
