Summary: A civilian named as Luqman Watani Al Zarzour was among up to four oil workers who died in an alleged Coalition or Russian strike on Al Bukamal, according to reports.
The attack on an oil refinery and the al Sina'a industrial area was attributed by most observers to the Coalition, while the VDC said it was Russia.
