According to the Smart News Network, "Three civilians and a member of 'Islamic State' were killed on Wednesday by a bombing likely to be by the international coalition in the al-Mashlaab district of the city of Raqqa, northeast of Syria". Almanartv also pointed towards the Coalition, reporting the death of an IS gunman in addition to three non-combatants.
