(b)(1)1.4a, (b)(6) was cued to the area and observed a mortar located in the doorway
of a school firing on friendly forces. From ()(1)1.4a, (b) s feed, the TEA determined that there
was minimal civilian transient traffic in the area. Noting the proximity of the target to a
protected object, the TEA selected (b)(1)1.4a as the optimal weapon to
neutralize the target while minimizing collateral damage to the school and limiting risk to
potential civilian transient traffic on a nearby road. The TEA approved the strike
pursuant to collective self-defense ROE, and the mortar was engaged at (b)(1)1 4a. The
round impacted directly on target and its effects were contained within the wall of the
school facility, and had little to no effect on the school itself. During the (b)(1)1.4e
