WHO: CJOC-E WHAT: Reported CIVCAS allegation from AFCENT, (b)(1)1.4a WHERE: Mosul, IZ/ (b)(1)1.4a WHAT WE KNOW: CJOC-E conducted a Strike on 3x ARMED PAX with a MORTAR TUBE on 15(1):14NOV 2016 at the location indicated above. This engagement was under ROE (1)1 43SD. The enemy was positively identified with a reasonable certainty to be Da'esh, engaging with Friendly Forces. [(b)(1)1.44 scans were conducted (b)(1)1.4a, (b)(6) WHAT WE DON'T KNOW: Post-strike, it was reported by AFCENT that the building across the street from the engagement caught fire due to secondary explosions from the mortar/mortar tubes, with local firefighters and emergency technicians responding. CJOC-E STRIKE CELL ISRLO is in the process of obtaining video feed from (b)(1)1.4a, (b)(6) for further analysis.
