Allegation	February 20th 2017: desert of al Jalaa town, Deir Ezzor governorate, Syria Summary: Two civilians died in an alleged Coalition airstrike in a car in the desert of al Jalaa, according to local sources.  According to Euphrates Post and the Shaam News Network, the two deaths occurred when Coalition jets struck a "Hyundai car carrying petrol in the desert of al Jalaa".  LCCSY reported that the "international coalition carried out several raids on oil fields in the east of the province." Al Amawi and Fresh Syria also attributed the event to the Coalition.  On April 30th 2017 the Coalition flagged the event as 'not credible', noting: "Feb. 20, 2017, near Dayr Az Zayr, Syria, via social media report: No Coalition strikes were conducted on that day in the geographic area of the reported civilian casualties."
