SUBJECT: CIVCAS Credibility Assessment Report (CCAR) for Allegation 1791, Rawah, Iraq, 26 October 2017

- 2 (U//FOUC) BLUF: I assess that the allegation of civilian casualties (CIVCAS) on 26 OCT 17 in Rawah, Iraq is NOT CREDIBLE. This assessment is based upon a thorough review of all reasonably available information, including information provided by Combined Joint Task Force Operation Inherent Resolve (CJTF-OIR) and open source material.

 - b. (U) Time and Location: 26 OCT 17, Rawah, Iraq
- c. (SUREL USA, MESE) Altegation: Notification of a potential CIVCAS incident involving (1)1.4a, (b)(1)1.4a BLUF: Potential CIVCAS event. Who: (b)(1)1.4a, (b)(6)

this strike and does not provide any information relating to observations of the target (Encl 7).

- e. (S//RELUSA, FVEY) Review of FMV/Weapon Sight Video(WSV): (b)(1)1.4a, (c)(6) served as both the ISR and strike asset for the execution of this strike. The only video available was the WSV provided by (b)(1)1.4a, (b)(6)(Encl 3).
- 1. (S//REL USA, FVEY) WSV From (b)(1)1.4a, (b)(5) Approximately 42 seconds of WSV was provided by (b)(1)1.4a, (b)(6) The video begins at 00:05 with the target facility in the center of the field of view (FOV). To the southeast of the target facility (in the street near the mosque) 1 X Person can be seen walking towards the mosque 10 USC 130d; (b)(6)

out to the Person begins to walk behind a wall next to the mosque. At that same moment, SPLASH occurs. The target facility, Residence 01, and the area where the Person was last seen are obstructed from view due to a combination of the smoke, dust, and viewing angle. At 00:32, the video cuts to BDA with the target facility in the center of the FOV. The target facility has been reduced to rubble and there appears to be significant damage to Residence 01 with a large portion collapsed to USC 130b (b)(6) continues to focus on the target facility for the remainder of the video, there does not appear to be an indication of CIVCAS or further activity in the vicinity of the target facility (Encl 8).

- 6. (S//RE USA, FVEY) Credibility Assessment: Based on a thorough assessment of all reasonably available evidence, this CIVCAS allegation is deemed NOT CREDIBLE. That is, there is insufficient evidence to corroborate this allegation.

SUBJECT: CIVCAS Credibility Assessment Report (CCAR) for Allegation 1791, Rawah, Iraq, 26 October 2017

- I have reviewed the information contained in this CCAR and the supporting evidence. Based upon all reasonably available information at this time, I find that:
- a. ___ The evidence supports a finding of <u>CREDIBLE</u>. That is, it is more likely than not that the CIVCAS incident occurred. I direct an investigation be conducted.
- b. ____ The evidence supports a finding of <u>CREDIBLE</u>. That is, it is more likely than not that the CIVCAS incident occurred. However, at this time I direct no further investigation, as no additional information could reasonably be discovered. Accordingly, CJTF-OIR CIVCAS Cell shall close this allegation and CJTF-OIR PAO shall publish the results of this assessment in a press release as soon as practicable.
- c. (b)(6) The evidence supports a finding of <u>NOT CREDIBLE</u>. Without additional evidence, I direct that no further action be taken by this command. Accordingly, CJTF-OIR CIVCAS Cell shall close this allegation and CJTF-OIR PAO shall publish the results of this assessment in a press release as soon as practicable.
