"SUBJECT: CIVCAS Credibility Assessment Report (CCAR) for Allegation 397 (Ahtemlat, Syria - 7 May 2016)

1. (U) BLUF: I assess that the allegation of civilian casualties (CIVCAS) on [date] in [location] is NOT CREDIBLE. This assessment is based upon a thorough review of all reasonably available information, including information provided by Combined Joint Task Force - Operation Inherent Resolve (CJTF-OIR) and open source material.

ASSESSMENT RESPONSE:

- 2. (U) CIVCAS Allegation:
- a. (U) Source: Local Civil Defence Committees, Al Jisr TV, Al A'maq Agency (ISIS), Syrian Observatory for Human Rights, Shaam News Network, Violations Documentation Centre, Al Walaa' and al Bara'a Agency, Aleppo 24, Syria Rebels, Alm Jhar, Zaman al Wasl, Fresh Syria, Qasioun
- b. (U) Time and Location: 7 May 2016, Ahtemlat,
 Aleppo governorate, Syria
 - c. (U) Description: Six civilians, including up to five

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children, died in a reported night-time Coalition Forces (CF) strike at Ahtemlat in Aleppo governorate, Syria.

- 3. (U) Analysis of Coalition Strike Activity: CF conducted one strike corresponding to the time and location alleged. My assessment focuses on this strike.
- a. (S//REL) Strike (b)(1)1.4 Overview: Strike number (b)(1)1.4 was a deliberate strike that occurred on (16)(1)1.2 MAY 2016 under ROE(1)1.4 that targeted IHTAYMILAT ISIL HQ at (b)(1)1.4 An (b)(1)1.4 paircraft struck the target with (b)(1)1.4 The (b)(1)1.4 was flown by (b)(1)1.4 (b)(6) An American asset. The strike resulted in one Joint Desired Point of Impact (JDPI) struck and confirmed moderate damage to the target facility.
- b. (S//REL) Review of Supporting Intelligence:
 IHTAYMILAT ISIL HQ was a double-story residential building located in south Ihtaymilat, Syria. Functional characterization of the target facility as an ISIS headquarters was supported with high confidence by(1)1.4c reports collected over six months, the most recent from 15 April 2016. The facility's former function was residential. The facility was assessed to have been under the exclusive use and control of ISIS since at least October 2014 and was no longer serving a civilian function. Pre-strike aerial reconnaissance captured seven hours of Full Motion Video (FMV) producing a slant of 4/0/0.
- c. (S//REL) Collateral Damage Estimate (CDE)/Battle
 Damage Assessment (BDA): The CDE call for this facility
 was (b)(1)1.4a One JDPI was identified in the CDE
 graphic. No collateral concerns were within the weapons
 effects radii of the weaponeering solution; however, prestrike intelligence identified an adjacent residence on the
 east wall of the target facility, and three other collateral
 concerns to the west, north and south, all within 50
 meters of the target facility. The BDA call for this strike
 was 1 x BLDG CONFIRMED MODERATE DAMAGE. FACILITY
 MODERATE FUNCTIONAL DAMAGE/LIM-OP. Although the
 post-strike BDA image is very poor quality, it does not
 appear that the collateral concern to the east sustained
 damage from the attack.

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- d. (S//REL) Review of Full Motion Video (FMV):
 Available FMV of this strike shows weapons penetrating
 the roof on the south of the target facility before going
 high-order from within. Several seconds of post-strike
 FMV were also provided, during which two individuals are
 observable to the south of (and possibly emerging from)
 the struck building. At least eight individuals are also
 visible on the north side of the building but do not appear
 to have been inside.
- 4. (S//REL) Additional Information:
- a. (S//REL) The (b)(1)1.4a, (b)(mission report (MISREP) noted that after impact (b)(1)1.4a, (b)(moted multiple "squirters" (fleeing personnel) from building. Upon review of FMV, (b)(1)1.4a, (b)(motes) gobserved two squirters from target building and eight "movers" (mobile personnel) from covered/tunnel structure approximately 10 meters northwest from target building.
- b. (S//REL) According to the WebOps summary of the aggregated reports in paragraph 2.a above, the Al A'Amaq Agency (an ISIS-affiliated media outlet) allegation included an extremely graphic video showing the bodies of at least two infants being recovered. However, this video is no longer available and was not reviewed for this assessment.
- 5. (U) Credibility Assessment: Based on a thorough assessment of all reasonably available evidence, this CIVCAS allegation is deemed NOT CREDIBLE. That is, there is insufficient evidence to corroborate this allegation. These findings were based on the following:
- a. (S//REL) All of the individuals observed in the poststrike FMV appeared to be ambulatory. Acknowledging that the quality and duration of the video is poor, my assessment did not observe the presence of any clearlyidentifiable CIVCAS.
- b. (\$//REL) Given that the Al'Amaq video was not available for my review, I am unable to determine whether the video's depiction of wounded infants could be credibly associated with the strike under assessment.
