December 10th 2015: Ramadi, Anbar province, Iraq

Summary: Eight civilians - including a senior veterinarian and his wife - were reported killed when three vehicles were hit in an alleged Coalition airstrike, as they travelled on the road between Ramadi and Rutba.

### DESCRIPTION:

Dr. Ahmed Hamid Al-Jumaily (pictured) - the director of a major veterinary hospital in Anbar - was killed along with his wife, and his wife's father. Four or five other civilians also died, named as Hazem Al Sarhan and his wife and children in what was claimed to be a Coalition attack. Ramadi had been the scene of heavy airstrikes for some weeks.

Civilians reported killed: 7-8, including 2 women, 2 children

Coalition position: For December 9th-10th 2015 the Coalition reported that "Near Ramadi, six strikes struck two separate ISIL tactical units and destroyed two ISIL boats, five ISIL fighting positions, three ISIL weapons caches, and four ISIL command and control nodes."

And for December 10th-11th it noted: "Near Ramadi, five strikes struck two separate ISIL tactical units and destroyed an ISIL fighting position, an ISIL bed down location, an ISIL VBIED, and an ISIL staging area."

Ar Rutbah is located approx. 280km WSW of Ramadi, IZ. All 11x dynamic strikes were located within the Northwestern or Eastern part of Ramadi, the closest being more than 7km away from the few roads that separate the 2x cities. There is no information on the approximate location of the alleged CIVCAS from airwars.org. Due to the fact there was no correlating Coalition strikes taking place between Ar Rutbah and Ramadi and because all strikes conducted IVO Ramadi were not on roads connecting with Ar Rutbah; the closest strike being 7km away. Without any additional information connecting Coalition strikes to the allegation's location, this allegation is assessed to be NON-CREDIBLE. Given the specificity of the location alleged, the fact there was no strikes conducted on roads between Ar Rutbah and Ramadi CJTF-OIR recommends no further action without any corroborating evidence.
