Airwars.org came back to us with (b)(1)1.4a as a location that is within 750 meters of the street. All strikes in Tabaqah for the dates in question do not seem to on or near that street. Accordingly, CJTF will close this allegation at the initial assessment.

After reviewing the allegation, the TF 94-7 strikes in the area, the relevant feeds and strike reports (1)1.4a, (b)(6)
(b)(1)1.4a, (b)xeas unable to assess the credibility of allegation #431 during the TF 94-7 CIVCAS review board today.
Additional information is not available to make a determination absent conducting interviews of the alleged casualty's family.

Media reporting indicates the strike that resulted in CIVCAS was on 21 APR 17. Between 20 and 21 APR 17, TF 94-7 conducted eight strikes in the Al Qariya area IVO Tabqah, Syria. Only two of those strikes, both executed on 20 APR 17, were in residential areas that could correlate to the area described in social media. The lack of specificity in the allegation and mismatch on strike dates prevents a credibility determination.

TF 94-7 requests this allegation be closed and be found inconclusive.

near central road. The other six strikes were in rural or non-residential areas.

(S//REL USA, FVEY) KS TF (b)(1)14a was a dynamic strike on armed ISIS fighters, staging for an attack at a compound in close proximity to SDF lines (within 6 minute movement time of SDF lines) in support of OPN (b)(1)1.4a (b)(1)1.4and pursuant of RO(6)(1)1.44Preceding strike (Figure 2), (b)(1)1.4a, (b)(6)maintained eyes on target building from (b)(1)1.4a z. At 20b)(1)1 ApaAPR 17, (b)(1)1.4a, (b)(6 observed three friendly weapon SPLASHES on building at (b)(1)1.4a assessed 2x EKIA,1x building destroyed, and no SQUIRTERS or civilians observed. From (b)(1)1.4a, (b)(6) scanned Tabagah and saw no indications of unintended effects or civilian casualties. (S//REL USA, FVEY) KS TF (b)(1)1/1a was a dynamic strike on an ISIS Headquarter Facility in support of TM SYRIA and pursuant of ROE (b)(1)1.4a, (b)(1)1.4c assessed active coordination of ongoing attacks coming from the HQ. (aAPR 17(b)(1)1.4a, (b) (sonducted a strike on the ISIS HQ Facility at (b)(1)1.4a BDA was assessed as 1x building and had no accompanying b)(1)1.4cNo CIVCAS were reported (by(1)1.4a, (b)(6) (b)(1)1 46 for the 25 minutes they were on station following the strike. There were no other separate observers, only the asset conducting the strike. For this reason, (b)(1)1.4avas 'Reported as Unobserved'.
