Yes October 10th 2017: '5') (1670) Rawa, West Anbar province, Iraq Summary: Yaqein reported heavy bombardments on Rawa by a Coalition aircraft, resulting in civilan casualties and injured as well as substantial damage to homes and vehicles. In a later report, the news agency seems to contest the air strike, referring to "heavy shelling by the international coalition". Similarly, a local report alleged "Artillery bombing on Al Qaim city and Rawa for offensive preparations." A local report named one of the civlians killed as Anas Malik Salamah.
