It was unclear whether Turkey or the Coalition was responsible. Ramaf reported that an attack hit a camp, claiming "the lives of three martyrs and [left] more than fifteen wounded as a result of being targeted by Turkish artillery. Ramaf named the three victims as Khaled Ma'rouf, Mahmoud Sheikh Nouri and Mohammad Adel. ISIL-controlled al Al A'maq Agency reported that 4 civilians were killed, including a girl "when two tents were targeted with an American raid." Civilians reported killed: 3-4, possibly including one girl.
