Allegation Description	July 19th 2017: (S1086) Raqqa, Raqqa governorate, Syria Summary: A woman was killed and her son was injured following alleged SDF shelling into Raqqa, local sources reported. The deceased woman was identified as the wife of Hamza Mohammed al Fahd and her injured son was identified as Mohammed al Fahd. Al Sokhna claimed Mrs al Fahd's unnamed daughter was injured. Both sources alleged that SDF shelling was responsible, however, Airwars understands that only the Coaliton is using artillery in Raqqa. The Syrian Observatory stated that "a female citizen was killed and her son was injured as a result of shelling by the "Euphrates Wrath" Operation Forces and the International Coalition warplanes after midnight on areas in Al-Raqqah city, which is considered the main stronghold of ISIS in Syria." Civilians reported killed: 1 Civilians reported injured: 1-2 Sources: Raqqa is Being Slaughtered Silently [Arabic] [Archived], Al Hasaka Rasd [Arabic] [Archived], Alsokhna Alhadath [Arabic], [Archived], Syrian Observatory for Human Rights [Archived], Quality of reporting: Fair.
